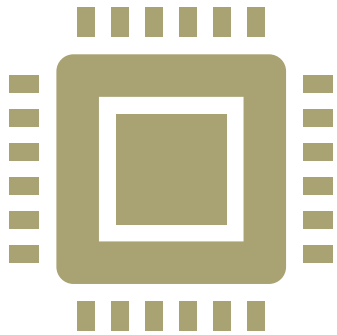

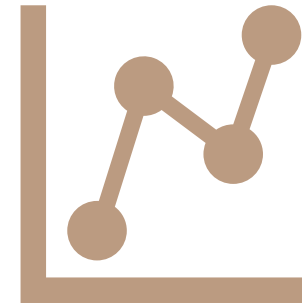

# What is InCites?

---



InCites is a web application from Clarivate Analytics.



Uses citation data to analyze research productivity and benchmark against peer institutions.

# InCites Dataset

InCites is built on citation data from the Web of Science Core Collection, which includes:

- Science Citation Index Expanded
- Social Sciences Citation Index
- Arts & Humanities Citation Index
- Conference Proceedings Citation Index (Science, Social Science & Humanities)
- Book Citation Index (Science, Social Sciences & Humanities)
- [optional] Emerging Sources Citation Index

Data goes back to 1980 and is updated monthly.

# Limitations of InCites

- Only includes publications indexed in the Web of Science Core Collection
- Poor author identity management, making comparisons of individuals difficult
- No college or department-level information, only "Research Area"

1. From the Libraries' [A-Z Databases List](#) or persistent URL: <http://purl.lib.uiowa.edu/Incites> (works on and off-campus)
2. Create an account
  - If you don't already have a Web of Science account. (Don't use your HawkID and password.)
  - If you have problems, contact [lib-impact@uiowa.edu](mailto:lib-impact@uiowa.edu)

# InCites Outputs

Save and share your work as:

1. Tiles - specific analyses consisting of:
  - data table (exportable as CSV)
  - visualization (exportable as PDF)
2. Reports - tiles can be combined and arranged into reports
  - Export as PDF
  - Share via email (recipients will receive a read-only link)
