### **InCites**

InCites is a citation-based evaluation tool for academic and government administrators to analyze institutional productivity and benchmark output against peers in a national or international context. This resource enables rapid generation of reports, as it utilizes data from the Web of Science indexes already part of the UI Libraries collection. Reports can be generated by the following categories: 1) people, 2) organizations, 3) regions, 4) research areas, 5) journals, books, and conference proceedings, and 6) funding agencies.

### **Data Management and Data Sharing Plans**

Research funders are putting a greater emphasis on research data management and data sharing. I'll provide an overview of how we assist researchers with creating well-written and actionable plans for their research funding proposals. I'll also highlight some essential ways in which our support can facilitate and improve data sharing and preservation, to reach larger audiences and comply with funder, publisher, and institutional guidance and requirements.

### **Evaluation Planning for Grants**

The Center for Evaluation and Assessment (CEA) is a team of faculty, staff, and graduate students that work together to conduct multiple forms of program evaluation and assessment in collaboration with colleges, universities, and school systems around the world. The CEA presentation will center on ways we can collaborate with UI faculty during the grant writing process to consider how projects submitted for external funding should be evaluated.
